

- Q But if I get it straight, the essence of the opinion 1  
that you got was that there'd be a less likelihood of 2  
finding the actual physical evidence of the -- of a 3  
ritual abuse, but more of a chance of finding photo- 4  
graphic evidence of the very same thing? 5
- A That's right. That's right. 6
- Q Okay. There were -- at that time, you mentioned two 7  
seminars or whatever you had attended with respect to 8  
this? 9
- A Actually, there was those two and there was also an 10  
F.B.I. agent came in from Quantico, Virginia, and spoke 11  
to us, too, regarding -- that was more of a general sex 12  
offender type of a seminar. 13
- Q And these seminars were put on by the Department of 14  
Social Services or by whom? 15
- A No. The one at Saskatoon Inn with Dr. Contie was put on 16  
by Social Services. The other one was put on by -- and 17  
I believe it's a society for prevention of ritualistic 18  
abuse of children, which Dr. Colin Clay from the univer- 19  
sity is one of the leading members of. 20
- Q And the purposes of these were to educate with respect 21  
to sexual abuse? 22
- A That's right, and ritual abuse. 23
- Q Ritual abuse? The ritual aspect of it? 24
- A That's right. And I also attended a seminar in Prince 25  
Albert several years ago in regards to the same thing. 26
